Dear Prime Minister, Viktor Orbán, I approve any HUXIT, I also want CZEXIT and SKEXIT. I'm writing to many European Union countries, because in the European Parliament on 3 January 2023 approved COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2023/5<sup>1</sup>, which is in conflict with another European Union legislation. ## Article 21

## **Non-discrimination**

- 1. Any discrimination based on any ground such as sex, race, colour, ethnic or social origin, genetic features, language, <u>religion or belief</u>, political or any <u>other opinion</u>, membership of a national minority, property, birth, disability, age or sexual orientation shall be prohibited.
- 2. Within the scope of application of the Treaties and without prejudice to any of their specific provisions, any discrimination on grounds of nationality shall be prohibited.

In the quoted text, I underlined religion or belief, in our countries (Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary) it refers to, for example, Seventh-day Adventists, Jews, etc. I also underlined any other opinion because there are vegetarians, vegans, etc. I refuse to submit to totalitarian behavior. I believe that it is necessary for people to decide for themselves what they want to eat and what they want to feed their own children. Please, Mr. Viktor Orbán, stand up for Hungary, don't be intimidated. I as the Christian don't want an aggressive way of solving the problem I'm writing about, but I also don't want anyone to be a totalitarian.
